



We would like to welcome you to Lampe Campground!

We hope that you enjoy your stay with us. Please stop by the camp office for brochures and a visitor's guide to discover local attractions and events within the Bayfront District and throughout Erie County. Reservations may be made 360 days in advance of check-in. No seasonal sites are available.

Restrooms, showers, and laundry facilities are located in the main building at the center of the campgrounds. Dumpster and dump stations are located to the right of the main gate. We also offer free public boat launch ramps at the adjacent Lampe Marina. Firewood and ice may be purchased through one of our attendants or camp hosts, located on site 26.

Attendants are available 24 hours a day. If one cannot be located on site, please call (campground cell) **814-434-3078** or (marina cell) **814-434-3656**. A courtesy phone is located outside the camp office for convenience. If you prefer, you may also locate an attendant at Lampe Marina's office.

For the safety and enjoyment of all our guests, we ask that you review and follow the rules and regulations on the back of this letter.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Site occupancy is limited to no more than 5 persons per site and must include one responsible individual 18 years of age or older.
2. Only 1 RV/camper per RV site. 1 additional tent is permitted if space allows. Only 2 tents per tent site. All items must fit within your site.
3. Check in time is 2:00 PM. and check out time is 12:00 PM.
4. Quiet hours are observed between 10:00 PM. and 8:00 AM. No visitors allowed during these times.
5. Campers are responsible for the conduct of their family/and or guests.
6. Children must be supervised at all times.
7. Visitors are not permitted to park in the campground.
8. Pets are permitted if supervised and kept on a leash. Noisy or vicious pets must be removed from the grounds. Pet litter must be cleaned up immediately.
9. The speed limit is 5 MPH, and all traffic is one way.
10. No parking on grass, roadways, or unoccupied campsites. If necessary, you may request a parking pass which allows overnight parking in the adjacent parking lot.
11. No tent stakes in the asphalt.
12. Alcohol is permitted when consumed responsibly by persons over the age of 21 and is limited to your own site.
13. Fires are only permitted in provided fire rings and must be attended at all times. The burning of refuse will not be tolerated. Fire rings are not to be moved.
14. No out of state firewood allowed. (Transporting firewood can spread diseases and invasive insect that can quickly kill large numbers of trees)
15. Campsites must always be kept clean and orderly. Trash including garbage, paper, cans, cigarette butts, etc. must be kept in proper receptacles and disposed of in the provided dumpster.
16. Draining black or gray water on the ground is prohibited.
17. Firearms are prohibited on all Port Authority properties.
18. Fireworks and flying paper lanterns are not permitted in the campground or surrounding areas.
19. All Camp sites are back in only.
20. The washing of RV's, campers, or vehicles is not permitted.
21. All rates are subject to change.
22. Charging of Electrical vehicles at pedestals is prohibited. Charging and unauthorized use may result in loss of electrical privileges or removal from the campground.
