ERIE-WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA PORT AUTHORITY
RAVINE DRIVE – SOUTH RETAINING WALL REPLACEMENT**

The Erie-Western Pennsylvania Port Authority (Port Authority) requests bids for the Ravine Drive – South Retaining Wall Replacement (Contract No. 12510-2026-06). The work includes the construction of approximately 115 linear feet of steel sheet pile retaining wall to replace a deteriorated concrete retaining wall at the southern end of Ravine Drive adjacent to its intersection with Crescent Drive within the City of Erie. The project work also includes the installation of new guide rail, the removal and replacement construction of a concrete headwall inlet to an existing 36-inch diameter storm sewer, and the restoration and pavement of the disturbed asphalt roadway surfaces. A pre-bid conference will be held at the office of the Port Authority located at 1 Holland Street, Erie, PA 16507 at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, August 3, 2026, attendance is recommended. Bids must be submitted to the Port Authority offices located at 1 Holland Street, Erie, PA 16507 by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, August 21, 2026, at which time the bids will be opened and read publicly. A sixty-day bid hold period applies, and ten percent bid security is required. The successful Bidder/Contractor shall be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price.
